Solution Waste Reduction and Environmental Impact Mitigation

Start lists, race documentation, and official results will no longer be printed on paper but will instead be shared through the dedicated Telegram group.

Throughout the competition days, separate waste collection bins will be installed both at the start and finish areas to ensure proper waste management.

Tenvironmental Education and Awareness

Race bibs will be made of reusable fabric, helping to reduce waste production.

The distribution of bibs will no longer be carried out using plastic bags divided by ski clubs; instead, a numbered rack will be installed for organized and sustainable pickup.

The jury meeting, involving representatives from all ski clubs, will be held online rather than in person, reducing unnecessary travel and lowering CO_2 emissions.
